TOP TIPS FOR A GREAT START TO CAMP

- Talk with your child about camp it's normal to feel nervous or anxious, especially when it's your child's first time at a camp. Connect with the Camp Director ahead of camp if you have any concerns.
- Leading up to camp, ensure your child is familiar with their belongings and everything is labeled.
 Review or practice daily routines such as getting changed for swimming or re-packing their backpack.
- Establish a routine, and be prepared that your child may be upset at drop off. Tell them who will be picking them up that day, and please let our staff know and we will gently help your child get involved in an activity and the tears will soon disappear.

LOST AND FOUND

- Clearly label with your child's full name any clothing and possessions that your child brings to camp.
- "Found" items that have campers' names on them are usually returned the same day or the next day
- Please leave all valuables and electronics at home. Check out our <u>cellphones and screens policy</u> here.

ALLERGY AWARE

- Please ensure that you inform us of known food allergies on the health form and discuss strategies to minimize risks with the Health Care Manager or Camp Director, so we can inform your child's counselors.
- Please provide a Physicians Care Plan and medication as needed.

DROP-OFF PROCEDURES

- Drive Slowly in the parking lot
- Leave cones in parking spots
- Stay in car.
- Pull forward when using drop-off lane
- Have camper exit car using door closer to building
- Any questions please call
- Do not hold line up

PICK-UP PROCEDURES

- Drive slowly in the parking lot
- Park in a parking spot
- Make sure to have ID
- Always check lost & found
- Read information board for important updates

Comfortable Shoes - Sneakers, NO CROCS!!

Medication - Clearly labeled with instructions (to be handed to the camp nurse). Sign permission to medicate form
