



Hi EOY Camp and After Care Families

Early Bird Registration for our Summer Camp is now open. I wanted to take this opportunity to review the process if you are a parent who receives or intends to receive state subsidy (ex. Programs for Parents)

Even though camp agreements and the camp license aren't available until next year you should register now to secure your spot as our camps are in high demand and waitlists are inevitable.

If you currently have Programs for Parents and/or had it last year during camp, you can register by paying 50% of the weekly deposit (\$5/wk) plus the \$25 registration fee. For example if you want to attend all 9 weeks of EOY Camp you would pay \$70 per child to secure your spot and for 7 weeks of MCE camp would be \$60 per child.

Please note the following

- Registration must be completed in person at our Welcome Center at 100 N. Arlington Ave
- If you qualify for P4P, whatever subsidy percentage you receive will be inputted on your account and any overages will be refunded to you via the method of payment we received.
- Refunds are expected to be received about 7-10 days after agreement is in the Program For Parents portal.
- You are still responsible to submit your signed preliminary agreement to the YMCA and once we complete it, we will email it to Programs for Parents
- If you ultimately do not receive Programs for Parents and still want to remain in camp, please apply for the YMCA Financial Assistance where awards could be 50% or more. If you receive other government assistance (SNAP, NJ Family Care, etc) FA is automatically awarded at 50%. <https://www.metroymcas.org/main/financial-assistance/>
